Thank you for submitting a proposal to the ITL Building the Future Program. We received 43 proposals. It was a very competitive evaluation process and the review committee made a number of tough decisions. On the basis of our [evaluation](#), we are writing to advise you that unfortunately your project was not selected. Please understand that we only have sufficient funding to support 17 of the proposals submitted, and so many high-quality proposals do not receive BTF funding.

We appreciated receiving your proposal. While we applaud the thoughtful proposal, we don't believe it aligns with the BTF goals of building new and future expertise in ITL.
